Why did you start travelling?

What is the most beautiful place that you have been to?

Andaman and Nicobar Islands. We often receive letters from our followers, in which they ask us whether it's safe to travel there, providing links to numerous articles about sand flies, crocodiles, snakes, dogs, etc. We are deeply convinced that Andaman Islands are very safe and extremely beautiful. The white shining sand, crystal clear blue water, palms and birds everywhere can impress even those who have seen everything. Of course, it is a remote destination, but we highly recommend going there to everyone, who wants to become a part of this bounty paradise.

What is your biggest travel dream?

We want to go on an Arctic tour. Unfortunately, it is too expensive for us now (we cannot even afford to buy appropriate clothes), but we believe that one day we will reach this destination. The South Pole is interesting as well. That's the place where not many travelers can go and one can feel the true remoteness and serenity every nomad is looking for.
