
4. Fountain of Neptune.

5. Palazzo d'acursio.

Bolognese call it Palâz. Palazzo d'acursio is situated on the Piazza Maggiore and it is the city's Town Hall.



6. Palazzo dei Notai.

It is beautiful example of bolognese Gothic architecture. Palazzo dei Notai was designed by Antonio di Vincenzo and built in 1381.



7. Castello di Galliera.

It is not top tourisit attraction, but you will see it for sure. It is right next to the Train and Bus station.

Nothing spectacular, but it is a good place to take a picture.
